# Annual Report 2006-07

Respected chair, Honourable guests, beloved manager and other members of trust, dear teachers, parents and dearest children.

I am indeed delight to stand before this august audience to present this annual report of Prashanthi Vidya Kendra. This report is only a brief survey of events, achievements and working of the school during the academic year 2006-07.

The foundation stone of this divine institution was blessed by Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba and consequently the school started functioning from 5-06-2000 onwards under the title of Prashanthi Vidya Kendra. The School is managed by Prashanthi Seva Trust, Bayar, Kasaragod, Kerala, which is the offspring of Sri Sathya Sai Seva Samithi Bayar and Sri Sathya Sai Organisation, Karnataka.

Prashanthi Vidya Kendra is a modern Gurukulam, a holy residential school with all the students living in the hostel. All the teachers live with them in the hostel and set inspiring examples. Wholesome vegetarian food is served to them all.

Education in human values or EHV, a system of education gifted tot the world by Bhagawan Baba is incorporated in the curriculum to bring about a fundamental transformation in the lives of the children. Balavikas classes and value oriented classes are arranged on every Sunday for the upliftment of our children.

This year several new students took admission in various classes. The school today has the strength of 271 students from different states. Statewise strength of students are as follows.

There are 20 teachers on the staff and 2 members on office staff.

The school is affiliated to CBSE New Delhi. We presented the first batch





for CBSE board exam in March 2006. By the blessings of Bhagawan many students passed with distinctions and first classes. Master Keerthi Subrahmanya bagged the 1<sup>st</sup> Rank in our school scoring 93.2% marks. Among the students of fifty one schools of Sahodaya School Complex, North Kerala, he scored 11<sup>th</sup> Rank. In the same exam, our students master Saichinmaya and Master Keerthi Subrahmanya become toppers by securing 95% marks each in kannada language. Both got a cash award from Sahodaya School Complex, North Kerala.

Our school team bagged 1<sup>st</sup> place in Senior level.

In the Sahodaya cultural festival conducted at Kannur, our student Krithi Amai of x<sup>th</sup> standard has placed in the grade of very good for her performance in classical music.

Co-curricular activities conducted on Saturday afternoon, openup a new world to the children who are tired of class room learning. The students fall to four houses; Sathya, Dharma, Shanthi, Prema and Sai Matha varied and colourful programmes like elocution, Karnatic music Fancy dress, Skit etc. are performed by the students under the guidance of teachers.

Sanskrit club functions in the school with a view to have an acquaintance with Indian tradition. It releases a weekly manuscript called 'Mayookham' in Sanskrit. English club promotes tastes of students in English literature and releases a weekly manuscript called 'Reflection'. Maths club make the study of Mathematics easy.

Our school curriculum includes the teaching of vedas, yoga, classical music, Drawing and Painting, Computer Science and Moral Science. To get the aware-





ness of democracy, we have a school parliament. Master Dhanush C. M. L. is the school pupil leader. On every second saturday we arrange school parliament activities. All the students are taken to the Divine presence of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba once in a year.
