The school started in the year 2000 under the efficient management of Prashar thi Seva Trust, Bayar. The committee comprises of 11 members. The successful performance of this institution is believed to be in the hands of our beloved Bhagawan.

School and Staff

We've a well established school building with spacious class rooms, office room, staff room, library, science lab, maths lab and a sophesticated I. T. lab. It also houses a magnificient prayer hall on the top.

I'm pleased to've qualified and experienced teachers who can dedicate their talents and wisdom in blossoming innate abilities of our students. In total, we've sixteen full time teachers and two part time teachers including an office assistant and an attender.

Students

Currently we've classes from fifth to tenth. Presently, there are 303 students persuing their study here. We're proud to've students from the states of Kerala, Karnataka, Bihara, Goa, Jharkhand, Maharastra and Uttaranchal. Two batches have already appeared for AISSE board exam and emerged out with flying colours by securing cent percent results.

Last year, the total number of students appeared for the AISSE exam was 26. Distinction- 24, First class-2. Master Nagana gouda S. P is the topper by securing 91.6% of marks. Four of our students- kumari Krithi Amai, Darshan S.C, Manjunath G. H, and Nagana gouda S. P have been honoured with subject toppers award by the Sahodaya school complex of North Kerala.

Co-curricular Activities

We strongly believe that, co-curricular activities are the integral part of



the development of our students. The institution provides classes on Veda, Yoga, Carnatic Music, Bhajan singing, moral science and computer literacy to the students. On every Sunday, we provide an interaction of distinguished personalities with our students to mould their character and to enhance their access to the society. We also conduct Balavikas classes regularly. Many of our students have participated in the national level drawing competition conducted by Kalabharathi child art institute, Maharastra.

Four of our students participated North Kerala Sahodaya chess competition held at Kannur. We are pleased to recognise the effort of our students in Sahodaya Kabady tournament held at Palakunnu. They secured first place consequetively for the second year. Master Sathish M. S of tenth standard was honoured as the best rider and Master Praveen Warad of ninth standard considered best all rounder of the competition.

Various clubs functioning in the school provides an abandant opportunity for our students to remain proactive, ajile and enthusiastic in various activities. Three more clubs have commenced their activities this year. Presently, we've six clubs working under the guidence of subject as well as language teachers.

Every second Saturday afternoon, students become cheerful to see the budding artists presenting their talents on the stage.

To get the awareness of democracy, we've a school Parliament. Master Adithya Bhat of tenth standard is the school pupil leader.
