ANNUAL REPORT 2011-12

School at a Glance :

The institution began in the year 2000 with the divine blessings of Bhagavan Sri Sathya Sai Baba. The 2.2 acre's of land donated by Sri Hiranya Narayana Bhat and Sons, the generosity of the Sai family members and selfless efforts of the management made us to stand with proud before you.

Knowledge is available in plenty but what is difficult is to know and find what is good. All we need is to adapt to change and to know how to use it in our context. The school aims at all-round development of the personality of our children by exposing them to various extracurricular activities there by expanding the level and range of their awareness and talents. We envisage the fruitfulness and fulfilment of value based education.

Academic :

The academic year 2011-2012 has been very purposeful and fruitful for our school. The year witnessed many milestones of excellent achievements in academics and co-curricular activities.

This year we've 362 students out of which 315 students reside in the hostel. They belong to different states of the country. Our 53 students appeared for AISSE exam in the year 2010-11 and brought 100% result continuously for the sixth time. Eight students have scored A1 grade in all subjects. I am very proud to inform you that 4 of our students Master Shambhulingayya, Master Prajwal K. G., Kum. Tejaswini and Kum. Sai chinmayee participated in the CBSE regional level science exhibition held at BGS International School, Bangalore and our project was qualified for national level.

Sports and Cultural events :

It's my privilege to say that the importance given to Sports and Cultural activities has been reflected in the performance of our students this year.

1. Our school participated in the North Kerala Sahodaya School complex Kho-Kho Tournament and emerged as winners consecutively for the third year in both junior and senior levels.



2. Our school team participated in the SSCNK Kabaddi Tournament and became the runners up.
3. Our Kho-Kho team also participated in the CBSE cluster level Kho-Kho championship and secured fourth place. The team also won the Best Discipline award out of 65 teams.
4. Our Table-Tennis team has participated in the inter-school Table-Tennis Tournament held at Kannur and secured IV place.
5. Our Shuttle badminton team has participated in the inter-school Shuttle badminton championship held at Kannur.
6. Our students participated in the cultural competition held at Perla in connection with Kannada Sahithya Sammelana and won many prizes.
7. Our children participated in many inter-school drawing and other cultural competitions and secured various grades.

Students Council :

To get awareness of democracy we have a school parliament. Master Nikhil. R. P. is the School Parliament Leader. On every second Saturday, school parliament activities takesplace.

Infrastructure :

The infrastructure and facilities in the school have been augmented from time to time by the Mangement.

* Smart Class :

Worldwide, there has been a strong push to get educational technology into the hands of teachers and students. With this reality in mind and to empower teachers and students with technology inside classroom, the HCL smart class project was implemented from the month of June. The project enables teachers to use digital resources such as graphics, animations, '3 D' images and video clips in addition to the Chalk and talk method of teaching. This result in a completely new multi sensory learning experience for students and helps them to improve their academic performance.

Parent teachers meeting have been conducted after first terminal exam. Remedial classes have been conducted for weak students after class hours to help them to cope up with curriculum.
