School at a Glance:

With the blessings of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba , being inspired by Swami's ideologies on education, Prashanthi Vidya Kendra came in to existence at this remote area in the year 2000. The generosity of Late Sri Hiranya Narayana Bhat and Sons who donated 2.2 acres of land and perennial support of Sai devotees have sustained and accelerated the growth of the institution.

I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of Prashanthi Vidya Kendra documenting its developments and achievements. The years 2016-17 was marked with many events and success stories. Achievements of the year:-

This year we have 371 students out of which 318 students reside in the hostel. They belong to different states of the country.

In the year 2015-16, 80 students appeared for AISSE exam and brought 100% result continuously for the 11th year. 20 students have scored A1 grades in all subjects.

Sports and Cultural Events:-

It's my privilege to say that, the importance given to sports and cultural activities has been reflected in the performance of our students this year.

- Our school Kho-Kho team participated in the North Kerala Sahodaya School Complex Kho-Kho championship held at Kannur and emerged as winners in both Junior and Senior level consecutively for the 8th year.
- Our school Kho-Kho team also participated in the CBSE cluster level Kho-Kho championship held at Thrissur and became the runner up and participated in the National Level Kho-Kho championship held at Odisha. Our team entered Quarter final round.

- Our Volleyball team has participated in Sahodaya Volleyball tournament held at Kannur and emerged as champions consecutively for the for the 4th time.
- Our school Kabaddi team has participated in the Sahoday School Complex North Kerala Kabaddi championship held at Kannur and become the runner up.
- Our Kabaddi team also participated in the CBSE Cluster level kabaddi championship held at Thrissur and Secured 3rd place.
- Our Chess teams both Seniors and Juniors have participated in the Inter School Chess championship held at Kannur and our junior team has secured 5th place.
- Our school shuttle badminton teams- Boys and Girls both seniors and junior teams have participated in the Sahodaya Shuttle Badminton tournament held at Kannur.
- 7 of our students have participated in the National Open Karate championship held at Kottayam. Master Hashmith Rai of VIII A secured Gold medal in below 35kg Kumite and Samarth A of X A secured bronze medal in below 65kg Kumite.
- Our Karate team has participated in Western open National Championship held at Mangalore and become the overall winners.
- Our Table tennis team has participated in the Sahodaya Table tennis tournament held at Kannur. Our Senior team has secured 3rd Place and Juniors secured IV Place.
- Our students have participated in the CBSE Regional Level Science Exhibition held at Global Public School Ernakulam. Our Boys team Model Safety flight has been selected to National level. From the last 4 year we have been exhibiting our models in the National level CBSE Science Exhibition.
- To ensure the overall development of the Students we have various clubs functioning in our school.
- To provide a platform for the development of literary skills of the students, we have been publishing a news letter. Prashanthi-8 issues have already been published.
- Many of our students have participated in the various interschool Literary and Cultural competitions. 14 students secured excellent grade in various activities. Master Akash of X A class has secured outstanding grade in the Hindi Essay Writing competition.
- One of our students Prajwal, IX, has secured 2nd rank in Mahabharatha Examination conducted by Bharatha Samskrathi Prithistana, Bangalore.

Students Council:-

- To get awareness of democracy we have a school parliament. The school parliament activities take place throughout the year.

Quality enrichment Programme:

The institute gives immense importance to quality enrichment programmes.

- The academic year began with a 'two day' personality development programme for IX and X class.
- 2 of our Social-Science teachers have participated in the Two day training programme conducted by CBSE.
- There were two training sessions for all teachers by Sri Sathya Sai Vidya Vahini team, regarding integrated education.
- Two of our Maths teachers have participated in the mathematics training programme conducted by CBSE.
- To keep the inspiration and enthusiasm alive among the students, a talk with motivational and spiritual videos is arranged every week.

Infrastructural Facilities:

The management has been striving hard to strengthen the infrastructural facilities of the school which will be handy in the smooth functioning of the school.

- This year a new basket ball court has been constructed.
- Construction work of a sophisticated swimming pool is under progress.
- This year 2 new bore wells have been drilled to meet the water needs of the children.
- A new 3 phase generator worth 2.55 lakh has been installed to provide uninterrupted power supply.
- A Rupees 2.5 lakh has been spent on roof work of the prayer hall.
- A statue of Lord Shiva has been installed at the entrance gate to enhance the beauty and divinity of the campus.
- A staff quarters for our teachers is under construction.

Health awareness programmes:

- A (T.T) vaccination campaign was held in the campus by PHC Bayar.
- Felaria detection camp was organized in the campus.
- Our students have participated in the AIDS Day Rally under the guidance of PHC Bayar.
- A school level cancer awareness programme was conducted in the campus.
