Achievements of the year:

This year we have 324 students out of which 279 students reside in the hostel. They belong to different states of the country.

In the year 2016-17, 85 students appeared for AISSE exam and brought 100% result continuously for the 12th year.15 students have scored A1 grades in all subjects.
