We have crossed many historic and momentous milestones during the past 24 years and today, our school is a dream destination for students, teachers and parents alike.

Starting with a small building in the 2.2 acres of land donated by Sri. Hiranya Narayana Bhat and sons, today the school is spreading across 10 acres of land, well equipped buildings and other amenities. More than 400 students from different parts of South India are studying here.

In the third year of its establishment, the school got affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi. In the academic year 2005-06 the first batch of 10th standard appeared for board examination and achieved 100% result and the saga of cent percent result continued thereafter. The school has participated in various district, state and national level sports meet, science exhibitions and cultural competitions and achieved significant success.

At Prashanthi Vidya Kendra, we set standards and goals for ourselves and strive hard to achieve them; be it in the area of academics, co-curricular activities, discipline, sports, leadership, values and more. We believe and respect all cultures of all communities and promote understanding and appreciation of their valuable heritage, culture and values. Apart from preparing the children purely to qualify academic demands, special efforts are being made continuously to inculcate 21st century skills in them and enable them to face the challenges of the competitive world as per the recommendation of CBSE and NEP. It's a matter of great importance to us that the students should carry forward the values they have inherited, excel in whatever they do and be role models for others in the society.

Achievement of the year

The academic year begun with 'Praveshothsava' on 03.06.2024. This year we have 402 students in our school, out of which 346 students reside in the hostel. They belong to different state of south India. As our school is celebrating its silver jubilee, once again the school has proved its academic excellence. In the year 2023-24, 79 students appeared for class 10th board exam and brought cent

percent result consecutively for the 19th year. Master Shashank S Gowda become the school topper by securing 98.2% in the board examination.

This year Prashanthi witnessed a very important milestone in its history. In connection with silver jubilee celebration, a very spacious open auditorium 'Sri Sai Rajathangana' was constructed in the school with the financial support of our alumni.
