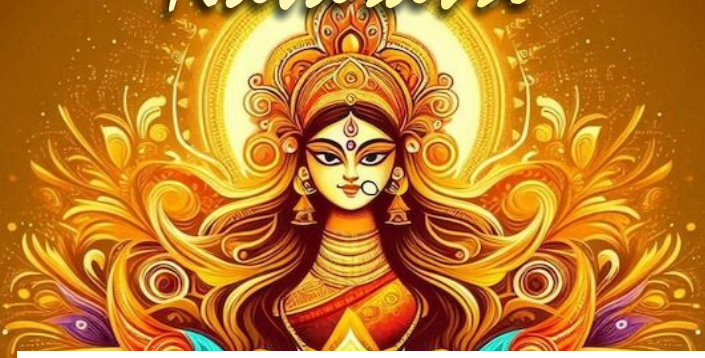
With this, we wish everyone a refreshing mid-term break and look forward to another month of learning, joy, and success.

Onam is Kerala's state festival and one of the most widely celebrated cultural event in India. It is a harvest festival that takes place in the Malayalam month of Chingam, generally falling between August and September. Onam is deeply connected to the legend of King Mahabali, a ruler who was loved by his people for his kingdom. When Lord Vishnu, in his Vamana avatar, asked Mahabali for three paces of land, the king humbly offered his head for the final step. As a reward for his devotion, he was blessed to return once a year to visit his people. The ten-day celebrations of Onam reflect Kerala's cultural richness. The festival begins with Atham and ends on Thiruvonam, the most important day. Families create pookalam, vibrant floral carpets placed in front of homes to welcome King Mahabali. People prepare and share Onasadya, a traditional feast served on banana leaves, consisting of more than 20 delicious vegetarian dishes. Thrilling vallamkali, or snake boat races, takes place on the backwaters, drawing huge crowds. In addition, traditional dance such as Thiruvathira, Kathakali, and Pulikali add color and joy to the festivities. Communities come together to sing, dance, enjoy games and fairs. Onam is more than a festival – it is a symbol of Kerala's unity, gratitude for the harvest, and pride in its traditions. Onam's spirit brings families, friends and communities together, making it an unforgettable occasion for all. “Onam Ashamsakal” to all.

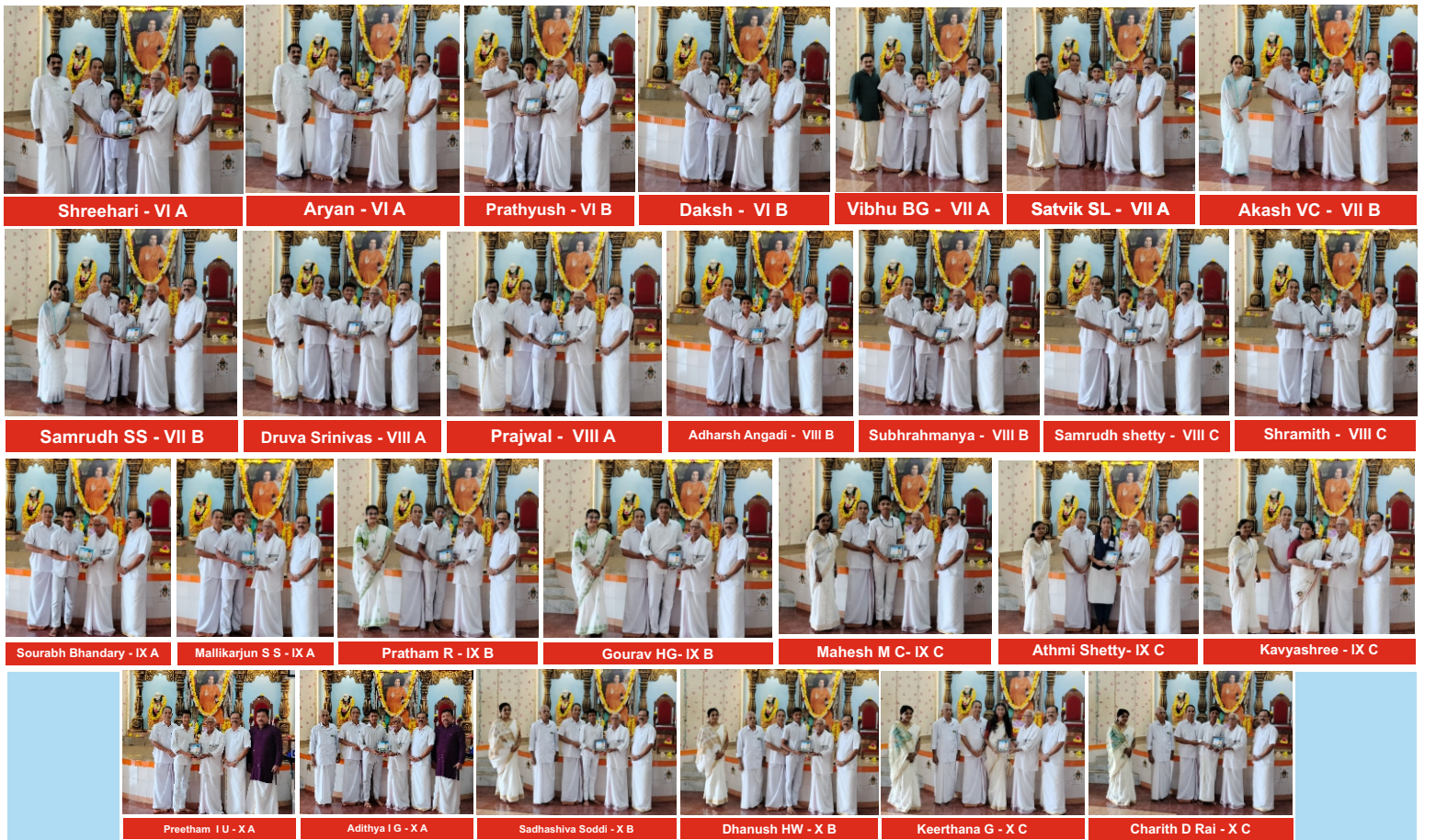
